Paying your fees	<p>Tuition Fees are due to be paid and completed by Orientation - 1 week before study commences, unless you are paying by instalments.</p> <p>Instalment payments are strictly due on the 1st of each month following the commencement of each trimester. Invoices will not be issued for instalment reminders. There are 9 instalment payments per year or 3 per trimester.</p>

Course Units	1 year course is made up of 15 study units. Fees per study unit are \$219 (VSL Student Contribution) or \$921 (full fees).
Late Payments	Payments can be made by trimester or monthly instalments. Payments over a week late incur a late fee charge of 5%. Payments over a month late incur a late fee charge of 10%. Credit Card payments incur a 1% charge.
General Services Fee	\$300. This fee is included in the Student Contribution or the Full Fees payment.
Course Materials	Depending on your course, subjects and load there may be an additional materials requirement. Full-time students will need to outlay approximately \$100-\$250 at the start. A Materials List is given at Orientation. PHOTOGRAPHY students are recommended to have their own Digital SLR Camera with video function and tripod (highly recommended but not essential).

VET STUDENT LOANS (VSL)

If you qualify, you can choose to access the Commonwealth study assistance scheme - VET Student Loans (VSL) to cover approx. 80% of your tuition fees. The remaining 20% not covered is your Student Contribution which must be paid directly to the college. See Student Contribution amounts in the VSL box above.

APPLYING & QUALIFYING FOR VSL

The college will help the student to apply for their student loan. Qualification for VSL requires that the student is an Australian citizen and in some cases, a New Zealand citizen, and that they have not used all of their loan credit. Prior completed study does not preclude applicants, nor is it means-tested.
