VSL	Trimester fees can be paid in three equal instalments over the trimester. VSL is not available for single subject enrolment.			
Fees Due	Tuition Fees are due to paid and completed by Orientation - 1 week before study commences. Instalment payments are strictly due on the 1 st of each month following the commencement of each trimester. Invoices will not be issued for instalment reminders.			
General Services Fee	\$300. This fee is included in the Student Contribution.			
Course	The Diploma or Advanced Diploma full course fee is \$13,815			
Course Materials	Depending on your course, subjects and load there may be an additional materials requirement. Full-time students will need to outlay approximately \$100-\$250 at the start. A Materials List is given at Orientation. PHOTOGRAPHY students are recommended to have their own Digital SLR Camera with video function and tripod (highly recommended but not essential).			

VET STUDENT LOANS (VSL)

If you qualify, you can access the Commonwealth study assistance scheme - Vet Student Loans (VSL) to cover approx. 80% of your tuition fees. The remaining 20% not covered is your Student Contribution which must be paid directly to the college. Please see the Student Contribution amounts above.

A part-time student is normally enrolled in 2 to 4 units per trimester. VSL does not cover single subject study unless the student is enrolled in more than one qualification.

See the table below. Your VSL loan is paid back to the government through a 1% tax increase at a later time when you are earning a salary of \$45,000, and increases slightly as your salary increases.

APPLYING & QUALIFYING FOR VSL

The college will help the student to apply for their student loan. Qualification for VSL requires that the student is an Australian citizen and in some cases, a New Zealand citizen, and that they have not used all of their loan credit. Prior completed study does not preclude applicants, nor is it means-tested.
